# GET HOOKED ON HELPING WILDLIFE

### TAKE ACTION

MIND YOUR LINE

Birds often get entangled

in fishing line, never leave

a line unattended

#### STOMACH PAINS

Over 90% of all Seabirds have plastic pieces in their stomachs

#### BIN FOR THE WIN

Roll up any unwanted fishing line into a ball.
Cut through the ball to make short lengths of line and place that into a secure bin

## DON'T GET HOOKED

Be careful when picking up or disposing of fishing hooks, especially if they are rusty

#### PICKING UP THE PIECES

Pick up any trash you see when you are out, even if it is not yours
